Dear Chief Secretary,

As you would be aware, the Atal Mission for ~~Revolution~~ ^{Rejuvenation} and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) has been launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister on 25th June, 2015. The Mission provides for infrastructure development in 50 cities/towns in order to improve delivery of services to citizens. The list of Mission Cities/towns under AMRUT in your State is at Annex-I. The Guidelines of the Mission are available on the web-site of the Mission (www.amrut.gov.in).

Planning is an important part of AMRUT and all ULBs will prepare a Service Level Improvement Plan (SLIP) that will be aggregated at State level into the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP). The SAAP will be prepared based on the annual allocation. The State-wise fund allocation has been made among States/UTs on the basis of equitable formula in which equal (50:50) weightage is given to the urban population of each State/UT (Census 2011) and the number of statutory towns in the States/UTs. The SAAP also contains Reform and Capacity Building components. The allocation of project funds and the size of SAAP to be prepared is given in Annex-II.

The work to prepare the SAAP may be commenced immediately. Rs.25.00 lakh per city is being given as an advance to each State to prepare the SAAP. Once the SAAP is approved by Ministry of Urban Development, 20% of the SAAP will be released to State Government to commence work on the projects. Approval for specific projects will be given by the High Powered Steering Committee chaired by the Chief Secretary, after the technical sanction of the same by the State Level Technical Committee.

I request you to establish the High Powered Steering Committee and start work on preparation of ULB level SLIPs for the Mission Cities.


OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT).

The undersigned is directed to say that the AMRUT was launched on 25.06.2015. The guidelines of the Mission are available on the website and copies have also been sent to the States/ULBs.

2. In Para 2.1 of the Guidelines it was indicated that the list of the cities/towns covered under the Mission will be notified at an appropriate time. The list of cities/towns in respect of Himachal Pradesh is in Annex-I. In Para 9.1 of the Guidelines relating to release of funds it was specified that immediately upon announcement of AMRUT, each Mission City will be given an advance of Rs.25 lakh from the State A&OE fund for preparation of SLIP/individual capacity building which will come from the ULB's share of the A&OE funds and will be adjusted in its share at the time of release of the first instalment. A sanction of Rs 0.25 crore for Himachal Pradesh has been issued vide this office sanction letter No 14012/103/2015-SC-II dated 24.07.2015 and the amount will be released shortly.

3. In terms of para 7.2 of the guidelines States have to prepare State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) upto three times the Central Assistance (CA). The CA is to be released in three instalments of 20:40:40. The first instalment of 20% only shall be released upon approval of the SAAP during 2015-16. The SAAP may be prepared at the earliest and submitted to this Ministry for approval. A table indicating the State/UTs wise CA, the amount for which SAAP is to be prepared and the amount of first installment is on Annexe-II.
